Built in 2000, Covington Estates is a portion of the master-planned community of Cross Creek. Covington Estates consists of 94 contemporary homes in the heart of 35 acres of wetland conservation areas. Homes range from \$200,000 to \$350,000, and this area remains one of the most sought-after gated communities in New Tamma.

Homeowners Association officer Ken Rodriguez loves Covington Estates because "it's very peaceful and everyone is friendly. It's a relatively small community. which makes it feel safe and comfortable."

Family-oriented features of the community include a 20-acre park and Little League parks, and it's close to the Flatwoods Wilderness Park.
